## **Tips**


- Check with your airline to see what services they offer to families traveling with children.
- Visit TSA's website (http:// www.tsa.gov/travel/specialprocedures/traveling-children) for information on the airport screening process.

- Bring new quiet toys or activities
   (like puzzles or crayons) to entertain
   your child while in the air.
- Pack a change of clothes for you and your child in case of spills or accidents.
